

BEST PRACTICE FOR STORAGE OF BURNERS

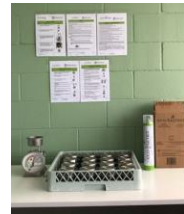
It is recommended that you set up a filling station in a well-ventilated area, away from naked flames.



Attach copies of the SOP's to the wall for easy reference by all staff.



Store the filling scales and fuel cans nearby.



We recommend that burners are filled straight after service so that they are ready before the next service. Wait at least 5 minutes after turning the burners off so that they are cool. Always place the burner upside-down on a level surface to fill.



Once burners are filled, store them upside down on a shelf or in a glass rack:

- An upside-down burner indicates it is filled - this will save time as staff won't need to check
- An upside-down burner will activate the overturn feature so no fuel can escape
- Storing in this manner will protect the burner and head
